Camp Discipline Policy

Discipline is most effective when it deals directly with the problem at the time and place it occurs, and in a way that campers view as fair and impartial. Counselors and administrative staff are expected to use disciplinary action (in the form of time-out from activities) only when necessary. Disciplinary action should be firm, fair, and consistent so as to be the most effective in changing student behavior. We will always consider the following: The camper's age, nature of the incident and the circumstances that led to it, camper's prior disciplinary record, and the effectiveness of prior discipline (time-outs). As a general rule, discipline will be progressive, meaning camper's first infraction will merit a lighter penalty, (a shorter time-out) than subsequent infractions. Camp counselors are instructed to inform the Camp Director if a camper exhibits violent behavior, bullying or a regular pattern of misbehavior. In such cases, the Camp Director will speak with the camper. If the misbehavior continues, the Camp Director will notify the Camper's parent/guardian to discuss possible options. In the case of violent behavior, we reserve the right to dismiss a camper from the summer program without warning.

Water: We encourage campers to drink water often during the session. Please send your child to camp with a refillable water bottle. Staff will stop for regular water breaks and campers will be encouraged to drink water throughout the session whenever they need it. Sugary drinks are *not* advised. Please remind your children to hydrate during the camp session.

Be sure to label all items with your child's name, including lunch bags and water bottles.

New in 2021: **Implementing COVID-19 Protocols**

We're doing our very best to remain current on guidance provided by the CDC for Operating Youth and Summer Camps during Covid-19, as well as information provided by the Orange County Department of Health. Governor Andrew M. Cuomo recently announced updated guidance for health and safety measures at child care, day camp, and overnight camp programs AS FOLLOWS:

FACE COVERINGS

- **Whenever social distancing is being observed, fully vaccinated campers and staff *are strongly encouraged, but not required* to wear face coverings.**
 - *Exception: When eating or drinking*
 - *Exception: Campers age 5 and under are not mandated to wear face coverings.*
- **All Campers aged 6+ and all staff, (including those who are vaccinated), will wear face covering whenever social distancing is not practical.**
 - *Exception: When eating or drinking*

A property-specific capacity limitation for children and campers has been put in place to ensure that appropriate social distancing is possible.

Facilities and programs **must** collect COVID-19 vaccination status (or-non vaccinated status) for all staff and campers.

(This does not mean the vaccination is mandated in order to attend, or work at the Camp.)

The following rules have been put in place for 2021:

- Drop off and Pick up procedures will be adjusted to ensure less people under the pavilion at once
- Conducting health check on staff upon daily entrance
- Implementing games and activities with an emphasis on social distancing to the best degree possible
- Hygiene stations will be set up throughout the camp area, regular handwashing will be encouraged.
- Encouraging use of equipment that can be sanitized between uses
- Campers will use sanitizer prior-to, and after 'playground time'.
- Groups of ten campers or less will be together for the day. Groups will not mix.
- No indoor days this year, although we hope for them to return in 2022
- No field trips as non-essential group-transportation for youth is discouraged.

We still promise to do our best to keep them busy and entertained!

Parents & Guardians: We need your help at home too.

- ❖ Please talk to your children about how they feel each morning. If they claim or seem to be sick, or have a temperature **please** keep them home.
- ❖ We've also attached three small posters to the Camper Application. Please share and talk about the information with your children.
