Being Prepared Makes a Difference

In the event of impending bad weather or local emergency such as flooding, road closure or possible loss of power and/or heat, it's best to be prepared in advance. The following is a tip list:

-Keep a battery operated radio on hand at ALL times.

- Have at least one phone in your home that does not need electricity to work.

- Keep a full tank of gas in your car.

- Have an adequate supply of the following: Prescription medications, Water, (2 gals, per person, per day) , Ready -to-eat canned food & powdered milk. Manual can opener. Infant/small children's needs; baby food, formula ,diapers. Specialty food for elderly or those with special diets.

-Contact your utility company in advance if anyone in your household uses life-sustaining equipment, such as dialysis machine , oxygen or a respirator. They can advise you on how to prepare for a power outage.

-Have a plan in place for those with mobility problems or special needs.

-Have a plan for pets as most shelters do not allow them.

-Have the following numbers readily available and close to your phone: Electric, Gas & Water Companies. Learn how & be prepared with the tools to shut off these services if it becomes necessary to do so yourself.

- Be sure your oil tank is securely fastened to the floor.

In the event of an actual emergency:

If you have power, tune your television to YNN OR Hudson Valley News Channel 12. If you don't have power, tune your battery operated radio to WHUD 100.7 or WSBK 104.7 . The Emergency Alert System will interrupt regular broadcasts with emergency information.

CALL: 2-1-1

Orange County, offers a comprehensive information and referral system linking residents to community health and human services and support. Callers seeking assistance can dial 211 (toll-free) 24 hours a day and be connected to trained referral specialists. Referral specialists have access to a database with information on more than 2,000 government and nonprofit agencies representing 5,000 specialized services, ranging from food and shelter to health care programs. You can also call 2-1-1 to access crucial public information in the event of a local crises such as earthquake, fire or other disaster.
